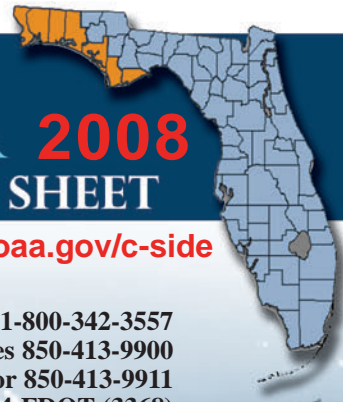

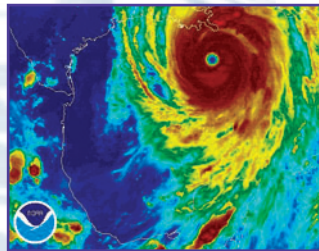

NOAA Satellites and Information Service (National Environmental Satellite, Data and Information Service) - NESDIS operates the satellites and manages the processing and distribution of millions of bits of data and images these satellites produce daily. The prime customer for the satellite data is the NOAA National Weather Service, which uses satellite data to create forecasts for television, radio, and weather advisory services.

A Personalized Travel Information Service

My Florida **511** is a free service of the Florida Department of Transportation. Travelers can dial **511** to access current information for specific routes and roadway segments, including:

- anticipated travel delays
- traffic accidents
- roadway blockages and lane closures.

When callers dial **511**, the service automatically connects to the most local **511** service available from the current location. However, you can transfer to other Florida area **511** services from any Florida location.

Through Florida **511**, callers will be able to receive information on all interstate roads across the state, including:

I-4, I-10, I-75, I-95, I-110, I-175,
 I-195, I-275, I-295, I-375, I-395, I-595,
 and Florida's Turnpike.

Callers can also transfer to a local **511** service for more detailed information and more road choices.

The My Florida **511** Website incorporates motion images from traffic cameras, e-mail alerts, public transportation information and customer feedback.
